DNEWS: live coverage of the coronation of Charles III, specials on the new monarch and new programs with the latest news from Latin America

May 2023 — **DNEWS**, the first live Latin American news signal for Latin America and the world, available on DIRECTV's network (channel 700 and 1700 HD) and on the [DGO](#) streaming platform, announced extensive coverage of one of the international events of the century: the coronation of Charles III of the United Kingdom.

In the framework of the coronation of the new UK monarch, which will take place on May 6 at Westminster Abbey and is considered one of the "events of the century", **Vrio Corp.**'s news signal will present a complete live minute-by-minute coverage of the events surrounding the celebrations.

With London-based special correspondents and all the first-hand information from the scene, **DNEWS** will air the news of the coronation during the previous days in its programming segments and will also have a **special broadcast** on Saturday, May 6, from 6 a.m. to noon (Argentina time), with all the images of the celebration.

In addition, to complement the transmission of the event, which will be attended by around 2,000 guests who will witness the coronation of King Charles III and Queen consort Camilla, the signal will broadcast two unmissable contents that will delve into the figure of the monarch.

On Friday, May 5 at 9 p.m. (Argentina time), it will premiere the program **Charles III** about the history of the new monarch, his relationship with his mother, his controversial marriage to Lady Di and his eternal love for Camilla Parker Bowles, as well as his relationship with Prince William and Prince Harry. Then, at 10 p.m. (Argentina time), the channel will air **Charles: The Monarch and the Man**, in which Jonathan Dimbleby, biographer of the Prince of Wales, will review the achievements of the man who is now king. From the announcement of his birth, Charles lived in front of the television cameras. This documentary draws on that rich archive to offer a portrait of the new monarch.
