



Brasilia: Vice-president Geraldo Alckmin received Darío Werthein

Alckmin received the businessman in Brasilia. They discussed the investment and expansion plans of the economic group in the country.

Brasilia, October 5, 2023. The Vice President of Brazil, Geraldo Alckmin, received Darío Werthein, president of Vrio corp., the holding company that controls the operations of SKY Brasil and DIRECTV Latin America, this Wednesday in an audience at the Planalto Palace.
