

DNEWS airs today the documentary Sobrevivientes del Terrorismo

DIRECTV's news channel will air chilling testimonies of five Latin Americans who faced the horror of the Hamas terrorist organization last October 7. The content will also be available on the live TV and streaming platform <u>DGO</u> in Argentina, Chile, Uruguay, Colombia, Ecuador and Peru.



Buenos Aires, December 18, 2023 – DNEWS, Latin America's first live news channel for Latin America and the world, will broadcast tonight *Sobrevivientes del Terrorismo* (Survivors of Terrorism), a documentary with testimonies of Latin Americans who were in Israel on the day of the bloody attack by the terrorist organization Hamas against civilian populations.

The original DNEWS documentary gathers five testimonies from an Argentinean citizen, two Ecuadorians and two Chileans who were in Israel on October 7, 2023, the day the war between that country and Hamas began, after the largest attack by the terrorist group in history.

The content will be available at 10 p.m. in Argentina, Chile and Uruguay, and 8 p.m. in Ecuador, Colombia and Peru on 700 and 1700 HD on DIRECTV's programming grid. It will also be available on the live TV and streaming platform DGO.

In addition, the interviews will be broadcast throughout the week on DNEWS, the only Latin American news channel for the region and the world, with live coverage from Argentina, Chile, Uruguay, Ecuador, Colombia and Peru.

Inés Grimland is an Argentinean who was in Israel visiting her family. She had traveled for the birth of her great-grandson, also a survivor of October 7. The horror found them at home and they were fortunate enough to escape the massacre perpetrated by the terrorist organization.

Daniel Nachari is a Chilean citizen who had been living in Israel for some years, thus fulfilling a dream that had accompanied him all his life. Gabriela Trebitsch, singer, also lived in Israel with her husband and two daughters; although she left after the beginning of the war, she decided to return despite the conflict.



Andrea Chimborazo is an Ecuadorian who has been living in Israel for years with her family and, after the war broke out, decided to return to her country to help Israel wherever she could. Finally, Estefanía Enríquez, also Ecuadorian, lives in Israel with her husband and son; she arrived in the country as a volunteer and then stayed there to start a new life with her partner.
